

	Generally Means...	Example...
Avoid	Avoid significant direct impacts, to the extent feasible	Physically avoid encroaching a resource (e.g., existing conservation lands)
Minimize	Reduce impacts	Change corridor location or design concept to reduce impacts (e.g., limit access in areas not intended for new development)
Mitigate	Offset impacts	Create new resources to offset negative impacts (e.g., new wetlands to compensate for project impacts)
Enhance	Create net benefits	Design corridor to enhance or restore resources (e.g., bridge corridor to restore water flow)
